

**UTTAR HARYANA BIJLI VITRAN NIGAM**  
**PRESS NOTE**

Chandigarh, June 18 – The Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam has decided to give two Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFLs) of 15 Watt free of cost to the people living below poverty line in its command area comprising district Panchkula, Ambala, Yamuna Nagar, Kurukshetra, Kaithal, Karnal, Panipat, Rohtak, Sonapat, Jhajjar and Jind. A spokesman said here today that the Nigam had already made the provision of providing two CFLs of 15 Watt each along with warranty card free of cost to BPL consumers at the time of release of new connections. Now, one time benefit would also be given to the existing BPL consumers having regular electric connections. He said that the Nigam has decided to launch a massive energy conservation campaign at grass-root level under which pamphlets and folders on energy conservation will be sent to each consumer along with the electricity bills during the next six months i.e. July to December, 2009. Exhibitions, seminars and competition of school students will also be arranged at each operation circle for mass awakening.
