PRESS NOTE

Chandigarh, Nov. 26- Keeping in view the persistent demand by the public, the Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam has decided to introduce the voluntary disclosure of load scheme for domestic, non domestic and industrial consumers of urban areas. The scheme will remain open upto December 31, 2009.

A spokesman said here today that no penalties will be charged from the applicant (s) for regularization of unauthorized load. The Nigam has also simplified the procedure for regularization of unauthorized extended load for the convenience of consumers.

Giving details, he said that for regularization of domestic and non domestic load, the applicants would be required to submit the Application & Agreement form. There will be no need of submitting the Term & Conditions forms or affidavits. However, the applicant would give an undertaking that he will abide by all the terms and conditions of the power supply.

For regularization of extended load there will be no need to submit the test report upto an extension of 20 KW of load. The extended load would be regularized after having necessary certificate from the applicant(s). They will be required to deposit the consumption security, fixed connection charges etc. and the extended load shall be considered as regularized immediately.

The industrial consumers may declare there unauthorized load by submitting Application and Agreement form along with test report. They need not submit any terms and conditions forms and affidavit they will deposit the requisite advance consumption security and service connection charges for the extended load.

The extension of load shall be regularized with the existing system i.e. lines and transformers etc. if they can take up the extended load. In case, the existing LD system cannot take up the extended load declared by the industrial consumers, the existing equipment/transformers would be augmented. In case capacity is not available in the feeding sub-station, then the consumer shall be asked to remove unauthorized extended load.
